Jetter Update: Chris reported that he went to Mississippi to look at the jetter. The unit was acceptable and was purchased for \$8,500.00. Deep South contacted Chris and informed him that they were headed to Vermont to deliver a fire truck and that they would place the unit on the flatbed and we could meet the truck on its way to Vermont. Deep South asked if the District would help out with freight. The cost to haul both units was \$4,600.00. Deep South and Chris agreed that the District would contribute \$1,500.00 toward the freight. Time of shipment is to be determined.

New Business:

Centrifuge: Chris reported that the centrifuge spun a shaft on the back drive unit. He explained that he did not know the cause and that the unit is disassembled and crated up ready for shipment to Texas for repair. Jim Stormont asked if the unit was under warranty. Chris said the unit is under warranty and that Andritz will be sending a tech back for install and start-up. Jon Draper asked how long the District can be down. Chris advised that this time of year we can hold sludge for two to three months due to the lack of loading to the plant. Chris will keep the Trustees abreast of the situation.
