Call to Order:

Jim Stormont called the meeting to order at 18:00 hrs.

Review of the Minutes of April 21, 2010

Old Business:

Signal Point Lighting: In his recent e-mails, Reed told Higgins he had recently dug up two other junction boxes in the middle section of the condominiums parking lot. In downloaded photos from Reed presented to the trustees at the May 5 meeting, the problems were obvious. The boxes revealed a few problems: water in one box (that is supposed to be waterproof) and a burned off wire in the other box. The caretaker informed the district that it would have to repair the damage. Higgins said Steve Dowdy would be coming to repair the damage that he admitted was poorly done. This repair work will be completed with watertight splices.

Centrifuge Update: Higgins reported that the torque centrifuge issues were close to being settled. The problem is programming-related and will require more "tweaking and finding the sweet spot" in the program.

Special District Meeting: Chris reminded the Trustees that a district hearing will be held at the Boothbay Harbor Town office on Wednesday, May 19 at 6 p.m. The hearing should be attended by home and business owners to discuss the upcoming pump station projects on Commercial Street and at the Meadow.

Chris reported that the crew collected soluble data for a month to send to Fuss for sizing of the blowers.
