DORA HIGHLANDS-REVISED DRAWINGS: The new construction drawings were reviewed. Paul Jarkiewicz explained the revisions and presented the time table for the project. Anticipated start up is July 24, 2006 on Park and Lobster cove Road.

SUNSET ROAD UPDATE: Pursuant to District letters sent June 8, 2006 and July 7, 2006 Mr. Alley's present was requested at this meeting, however, Mr. Alley's attorney contacted the District and advised that the wastewater contract would be here early next week at the latest. Therefore, no action was taken to discontinue service to the subdivision.

BUDGET REQUEST-ph ADJUSTMENT CHEMICALS: Chris asked the Board to allow the expenditure of up to \$3,000.00 for ph adjusting chemicals. Chris explained that this is typically not needed and was not budgeted for this year. The SBR tanks need to be maintained at or above 6.8. Currently, the tanks are at 6.1.

Robert Muller made a motion to allow the expenditure not to exceed \$3,000.00 Paul Jarkiewicz asked that the motion be amended to a not to exceed amount of \$5,000.00 because of fluctuations in the chemical market. Robert Muller allowed the amendment, by seconding the amended motion. Vote to allow the expenditure of not to exceed \$5,000.00 for ph chemicals was unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS: Gene Damon called and complained of the new grease trap inspection fee. Gene indicated that the fees were excessive and that the District was creating and unfriendly business climate in town.
